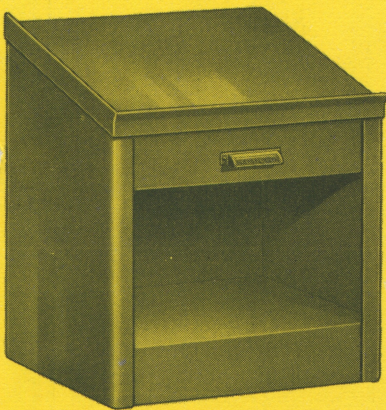

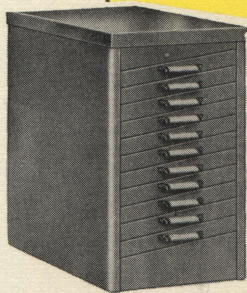

The Hamilton Operator's Cabinet provides convenient, compact storage and working space for copy, small mat trays, and drawers of sorts matrices or other frequently used material. Its slanting top has retaining edges at the left and bottom. Automatic drawer stops prevent accidental spilling of contents, and the cabinet moves easily on sliding shoes.

The cabinet is of all steel construction, finished in gray baked enamel, and is available with from one to four drawers, according to your storage requirements. Drawers may be blank or equipped with full-size inserts for holding matrices (optional at additional cost).

Specifications: floor space, 14 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ "; height at front, 22 $\frac{3}{4}$ "; height at back, 26 $\frac{1}{8}$ ".

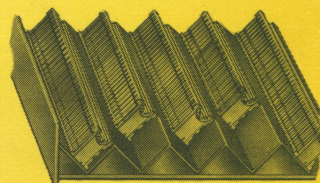

The eleven-drawer, all steel Hamilton Matrix Cabinet stores up to 161 lineal feet of matrices for immediate selection by the operator. Drawers are inclined and hold matrices along saw-tooth shaped grooves. Each drawer is equipped with ten metal separating slugs. Combination pull and label handles permit easy indexing, and all drawers can be securely locked by the single control at the top of the cabinet.

Inclined, grooved inserts each hold up to 105 lineal inches of matrices for quick selection by the operator. Each insert is supplied with six cast iron slugs to separate fonts or support the last matrix in a row. Inserts are optional equipment at additional cost.
