Each line was set on one slug and on one single-magazine machine. The black face figure matrices were cut according to our advertising figure layout, running in the following channels:

The characters eliminated or withdrawn from the magazine, in order to equip the machine for telephone directory work, are unimportant, and can be placed on the sort tray while the directory is being set and replaced in the magazine after the job is finished.
