FONT SCHEMES

Ladlow font schemes are worked out on the basis of the verzego line to be set on the 224-ben slug or multiple of the 224-ben slug. The font schemes have not been "locaded" but help are large onough for average requirements. They are not intended to be large enough for the setting of long streamer lines in all point sizes. When fonts are purchased for such a purpose, a font plus a sorts font, or a double font, should be ordered.

Since standard fonts are made only to fit average requirence, care must be taken when selling users who may have unusual requirements. For example, Kankekee, Illinois, users will require additional K's in all fonts, Millville, New Jersey, users will require additional L's in all fonts, etc.

SORTS PRICES

The standard sorts price per matrix listed opposite the font prices in the Contidential Manual is approximately the price per matrix obtained by dividing the font price by the total number of matrices in a font.
